Rough River Lake has approximately 150 miles of shoreline to keep clean. In recent years, we have seen 2.1 million visitors at our lake! As we often have in the past, the Friends of Rough River Lake is working with our Corps of Engineers to keep our shoreline looking good and free of trash and unnatural debris.

We are encouraging each Subdivision to organize a weekend during Winter Pool when the shoreline in front of your properties can be cleaned up. If each subdivision would coordinate a "clean-up weekend" for their neighborhood, we can have a substantial impact on keeping our lake clean. A few subdivisions have already participated and we have collected 13 large containers of trash to date.
